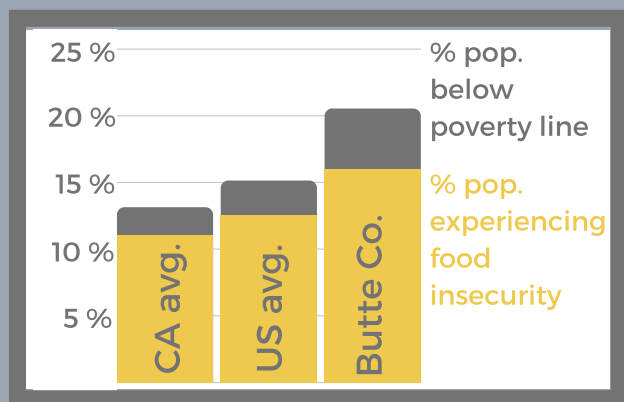
ORONAZ IS PARTNERING WITH THE FATHER'S HOUSE TO MAKE SURE THAT

WHAT IS THE FOOD BANK?

- In 2006, The Father's House opened the Mount of Olives food bank with help from the Oroville Nazarene church.
- In 2018 the food bank was rechristened The French Family Food Bank, in honor of Doug & Yvonne French, who helped found the Food Bank and worked tirelessly for years to secure food donations.

WHY DO WE NEED IT?

- Butte County has seen massive flooding (2017), catastrophic wildfires (2018) and now COVID-19. As a result, food insecurity has increased in an area that has historically struggled with poverty.
